

Dear Friends,

Every now and again, each of us has an experience t the world and gives a new context to use when refle n on disconnected circumstances. Such an experience was mine w thanks to a gift from a friend, I was given the opportunity to to see the sights that I had long anticipated.

When asked what I wanted to visit during my days in Paris I home at Giverny. Having admired impressionist artists for many yea intoxicated by the beautiful hues and images of nature that are feature longed to see his home and observe the surroundings that had influen of the time spent at Giverny was a pervasive sense of beauty and pe landscape.

Filled with a kaleidoscope of color, subtle fragrances and breathtaking design, t landscape was composed of a perfusion of individual perfect components. Th at Giverny, resplendent with their spring blossoms and the beautiful April air, on again and again in my thoughts since returning to Western New York. I would like to share the happenings of the past year at D'Youville with you by reflecting on them in th context of my hours at Giverny.

the Grey Nuns: gratitude and celebration

Of note during this past year at D'Youville was the commemoration of the founding of the Grey Nuns of the Sacred Heart. Although the Grey Nuns founded D'Youville College—

and prior to that Holy Angels Academy—it was specifically the Grey Nuns of the Cross from Ottawa, Canada, who traveled to the United States in the mid-1800s and ministered to the people of this region.

In 1921, observing the need for an English-speaking novitiate for young women from the United States who desired to enter the order, a number of the Grey Nuns who were involved in D'Youville and Holy Angels decided to separate from the motherhouse in Ottawa and to establish a congregation of Grey Nuns in the United States. In the summer of 1921, those valiant individuals, with the approbation of the Holy Father and the Bishop of Buffalo, established the first United States' motherhouse of the Grey Nuns and, bonding together, formed the congregation now known as the Grey Nuns of the Sacred Heart, changing forever the landscape of Western New York. In this, the Grey Nuns 90th year, the college celebrated their remarkable contributions to this city, particularly to the people of Buffalo's West Side, and also their greater ministry throughout the United States and in other missions worldwide.

s a sign of gratitude and celebration, the college chose as its principal service project or 2011-12 the commitment to the issue of hunger, locally, nationally and internationally. e are pledging our resources of creativity, people, industry and funding to provide many alternative ways that members of the D'Youville community can alleviate the er of others. College members will be engaged in direct work with the poor and e hungry through local soup kitchens and charitable organizations and will provide ational relief through fundraising efforts and a use of knowledge and research y less expensive means of combating hunger in faraway countries.

coming together for one singular purpose

Many parts of D'Youville have changed during the past year, each of which has in some way changed the college as a whole.

THE ACADEMIC FACILITIES Newly equipped pharmacy and science labs provided by a generous donation from Mrs. and Dr. Charles Bauer enable the pharmacy faculty to engage in state-of-the-art research. The Montante Family Library has been equipped with approximately 100 new computers so that students can have access to the latest technology for their study purposes and will have staff available to assist in supporting their technology needs. A simulation lab for the nursing students has been equipped





through the assistance of a federal grant, which has dramatically improved the learning experience of the students in that program. The computer lab in the new D'Youville Academic Center has expanded its hours to make the facility available to students at times when they most need to prepare papers, do research or locate other materials for their assignments. Each of these improvements plays a valuable part in the preparation of D'Youville's future.

As these computer centers and innovative technology pop up all over campus, it reminds me, of course, of the array of flowers and colors in the Giverny gardens all coming together as parts of a greater harmonious whole. Just as Monet drew together many pockets of beauty in his environment, similarly D'Youville has equipped each building with the technology, computers and accoutrements needed to assist students for a successful college experience.

THE FARGO AVENUE TRANSFORMATION The summer of 2011 saw the completion of a ten-year effort to redesign Fargo Ave. between Porter Ave. and Connecticut St. The new traffic circle and its handsome walkways have not only made the street safer for those who use it, but have unified the college in an important way. The plantings and trees will add to the campus' appearance. As I watched the workers transform that street day by day, it reminded me of the many circles of floral beauty in Giverny's garden much like a mandala that somehow comes together to remind us of the evolution and revolution of life.

STUDENT DIVERSITY IMIT Mirroring the varied hues in Monet's garden, D'Youville has added to its student diversity by welcoming students from around the world. The number of international students has increased, and the diversity of the background of these students has enriched the college once more. These students, with their ability, optimism and focus, have inspired all of us at D'Youville to give our utmost to broaden our educational excellence to provide the learning experiences necessary for these students from throughout the world. They bring to the campus an ebullient spirit and a sense of brotherhood and sisterhood that is difficult to replicate in any other way. They confirm our belief that we are all one and that we are all a part of the larger world community that God created.

the rough and rugged oak

Just as the Giverny gardens filled my eyes with beauty so, too, the experience reminded me of struggle. The rough and rugged oak tree, with its age and coarseness, reminded me that life is not without its struggles and challenges. The strength of the oak tree, however, suggests the ability of the human person to withstand trial and, through it, to achieve even greater accomplishments. D'Youville, too, has felt the effects of time.

LONG AND SUCCESSFUL TENURES We noted with sadness this year the retirement of a number of the members of this community – Sister Mary Brendan Connors, Sister Mary Kathleen Duggan, Dr. Carole Gutt and Dr. Patricia Palumbo – who have served the college for long and successful tenures. Their dedication and achievements will be a lasting legacy



that will assist the college to have the foundation to meet and conquer the challenges that lie ahead.

ENABLING THE PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED The past year, also, has seen the college community grapple with the needs of students who are physically challenged. Through these months, the college has worked arduously against what sometimes seemed to be insurmountable obstacles, to provide accessibility to the buildings that, because of their construction, dare to be modified. In 2010-2011, significant progress has been made in the Koessler Administration Building. These efforts, though painstaking, are worthwhile, and D'Youville is committed to making its entire campus accessible in the very near future. To achieve that goal, the college will continue to modify restrooms, entrance ways, parking areas, classroom space and social areas for the foreseeable future and will make steady progress toward achieving full accessibility.

SERVICE FOR OUR VETERANS Despite setbacks in federal funding, the veterans' program has grown to major proportions and has recruited to the college a number of men and women who are devoted, accomplished and enthusiastic. These mature students not only increase the numbers at D'Youville but, more important, they provide a tremendous spirit and example to others on the campus. In spite of the difficulties faced by setbacks in federal funding, D'Youville is struggling to find financial aid for these valiant men and women.

The change in the national economy and the influence of world economic conditions has alerted D'Youville to the need to provide even more extensive financial aid for students. Many able and dedicated students find that they are unable to meet the financial obligation of college tuition and expenses. Although D'Youville has been successful in maintaining a modest tuition, there is a constant struggle to balance the ability of the students to pay with the necessity of providing a first-rate education. These challenges will continue through / the next years at least as our state and national economies are strained.

Gazing into the still waters at Giverny makes one reflect on the present and the future. The opportunities for D'Youville's future is almost unimaginable.

PHARMACY'S MISSION AND MINISTRY The new pharmacy program, in its second year, has more than 120 students and will continue over the next several years to bring in additional classes of capable, competent, energetic and enthusiastic students. The entire pharmacy school community is engaged in D'Youville's mission and ministry and is dedicated to using their talents and education to make life better for others through this outstanding program.

THE DYC "BRAND" After months of interviews, surveys and deliberation, D'Youville has selected its new branding statement and identifying logo. With vehement support from all stakeholders, the college tagline – *Educating for Life* – was selected as most descriptive of D'Youville's mission. New commercials, billboards and publications have been developed



featuring students and faculty who say in their own words what the D'Youville experience means to them.

THE COLLEGE'S

Although uncertainty in the financial markets continued to challenge fundraising efforts in 2010-2011, according to the 2010 Voluntary Support of Education survey, giving levels in 2010 were significantly better than in 2009, but have not yet returned to prerecession levels. Giving in 2010 was at the same level it was in 2006.


Nearly \$3.2 million in gifts and grants was raised in 2010-2011. Unrestricted gifts are important to the college for directing revenue to the area with the greatest need. In 2010-2011, total unrestricted revenue raised through annual giving, unrestricted bequests and the Health Care Awards Dinner totaled \$414,955, which was 101 percent of the goal of \$410,000. Indicative of the economic climate in which we find ourselves, the number of alumni who raised their gifts this year over last year (including new donors totaled 697 compared to 1,160 last year. Consistent annual gifts from these new and generous donors will be a key to D'Youville's continued success.

Online giving continues to expand and has become an important strategic initiative for increasing charitable donations to D'Youville. In 2010-2011, the alumni online community grew from 439 to 813. This was attributable to an ongoing campaign to encourage alumni to enroll. Over 89 percent of visitors logged in regularly to our continuous efforts to update the contents of the site.

It is often said that the case for support of an organization is validated by the generosity of those closest to it. In 2010-2011, faculty and staff donors as well as the D'Youville College board of trustees donated more than \$61,680 to the Loyalty Fund. In addition, the board of trustees attained over 91 percent participation in terms of support to the college.

Major gifts to the college also come in the form of bequests, by which generous and foresighted benefactors have made provision for D'Youville College in their estate plans. In 2010-2011, six major bequests were received totaling \$326,942 from the following alumni and friends: Marjorie M. McGowan Demerly '39 (residual , Alice R. Riehle Riley '30 residual , Margaret P. Curry '46, Lucille A. Austin Gibbin '49, Angeline Malachowski Pantera '41 and Mr. Charles Stein.

This past year was especially productive in private grants development. Foundation grants provided over \$480,000 in support. Specifically, an award of \$100,000 was received from the Vincent and Harriet Palisano Foundation, an \$83,000 award from the James H. Cummings Foundation, a \$45,000 grant from the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo, a \$25,000 award from the Children's Guild Foundation and a \$20,000 grant from the J.M. McDonald Foundation.



Through rigorous efforts by the college's own grants department, D'Youville realized a surge of government support: more than \$1.6 million was generated for college programs. Notably, D'Youville was the recipient of a Nursing Workforce Diversity grant from the US Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS amounting to \$933,605 over three years, \$249,810 from the US Department of Education for the Upward Bound program, \$218,803 from US DHHS for scholarships for disadvantaged students, \$239,716 from NYS Energy Research and Development Authority and \$279,060 from US DHHS for equipment to enhance training for health professionals.

It is most gratifying to pay tribute to those whose names are listed on the following pages. The support of these donors—our alumni, friends, trustees and community foundations is clear evidence of lasting loyalty to the college and its high education standards. It is this powerful support that validates D'Youville's education goals and service ethics, affirming the college's mission and sustaining the compassionate spirit of Saint Marguerite d'Youville.

IRA ROLLOVER WINDOW CLOSING QUICKLY

When D'Youville's fiscal year closed in May 2011, several alumni had taken advantage of the Tax Relief Act of 2010 and made gifts directly from their IRAs to the College.


Under current legislation, this opportunity is available only for the balance of the 2011 calendar year, ending on December 31, 2011. This law allows individuals starting at age 70 1/2 to direct up to \$100,000 per year from their individual retirement accounts (IRAs) to eligible charities, such as D'Youville College, without counting the distributions as income for tax purposes.

SCHOLARSHIPS OPEN DOORS

"I am from the country and going to a city school is a big change for me," says **Jocelyn Gleiser '11**. "Since I grew up in a rural setting, I am more comfortable with a personalized educational setting. When I visited D'Youville for the first time, I felt comfortable here and knew it was the school for me." But Jocelyn wasn't sure her family could afford a D'Youville education. "D'Youville filled the bill in all aspects of what I was searching for, except for the category of what my family and I realistically could afford."

Thanks to the **Alphonso & Charlotte O'Donnell Kusmierski '32** Endowed Scholarship, Jocelyn was able to enroll in D'Youville's sixyear program ending with a MS in occupational therapy. Now a senior, she enjoys the close-knit community of students and professors in the program. She is active in the DYC Student Association and she has volunteered with Friends of the Night People, a local soup kitchen.

Jocelyn remains deeply grateful for the scholarship she received. "If it were not for the individuals who created and those who contribute to this scholarship fund I would not be on my way to realizing my dream of serving others as an occupational therapist," she explains. "I am grateful to all those who donate to D'Youville because they are making an investment in my future and to those who will come after me." For recent alumna **Catherine Muth '11**, a scholarship meant she could transfer to D'Youville to enroll in the global studies program. "My college career began at a large state school, but it did not take long for me to realize that it was not the right fit for me," she says.

With a dream of working in international relations, Catherine was intrigued by different cultures and the way they relate to the United States. "I realized that D'Youville, which was my mother's alma mater, might be more in keeping with offering me the opportunities needed to achieve my career goal." However, comparing the cost of attendance, Catherine realized tuition could be an obstacle, but with help from the **Marjorie McGowan Demerly '39** Endowed Scholarship, Catherine was able to realize her dream and transferred into D'Youville. As a global studies major, Catherine studied abroad in Madrid, Spain, and gained valuable experience as a summer intern at the Canadian Embassy in Washington, D.C. She also traveled to Boston, Mass. to participate in the Harvard Model United Nations conference, to enrich her academic experience.

This past May, Catherine completed her bachelor's degree in global studies and history. Today, she lives in Washington where she attends graduate school. "Had it not been for the generosity of those who came before me, I would not be where I am today," she explains. "To know that others believe in the value of a D'Youville education and contribute specifically in order to support those who attend today, means a great deal to me."

ALUMNI SUPPORT MATTERS

Catherine and Jocelyn could not have attended D'Youville without scholarships funded through alumni generosity. Doors to their future were opened and a lifelong relationship of friendship and appreciation was begun. Endowed scholarships such as the ones they received bring exceptional and talented students to D'Youville to pursue their passion and achieve their career dreams like many alumnibefore them. In the early '20s, a young Pauline Alt '28 was eager to start her college education at D'Youville. With her family unable to afford tuition, she appealed to then-president of D'Youville, Sister Mary of Good Counsel Kirwan, for admission, which was granted. She thrived at D'Youville and in all of her subsequent academic pursuits, eventually earning a doctorate. Grateful for her education, Dr. Alt established a scholarship fund for students and throughout her life remained a generous and loyal alumna. In June 2003, in recognition of a generous bequest to D'Youville College, the Health Science Building was renamed in her honor.

Thelma Fleisch '43 also benefited the college with a generous bequest that was directed toward a scholarship in business. Having majored in business, Thelma's scholarship assists students in accounting, international business and business-related programs.

Recently, **Mary Moriarity Cottrell '45** established two scholarships, one to honor the memory of her lifelong friend, Maureen Hutchinson '45; the second, named for Mary and her husband, Joe. Mary, when asked why she had done this, said: "My years at D'Youville were in the midst of the horrors of World War II. My brother was a casualty of the war, but our classmates were such a consolation to my sister Kay and me, that I could never forget such acts of kindness. I cherish the precious friendships I made during those years. I am pleased to be able to assist current and future D'Youvillians to experience the advantage of an outstanding D'Youville education just as I had received."

When asked why she decided to establish her scholarship, **Christina Barth Eberl '67** explained it this way: "My family always considered education among the highest priorities. They strongly encouraged me and my sister and brother to do well in school. I am pleased to say that the D'Youville alums I know are of the very highest caliber. They are women who contributed enormously to their communities. I believe that is because it is in the tradition of the Grey Nuns and faculty to provide the finest education. I wanted to continue to provide for our students now and in the future." Chris honored her faculty mentor by creating the Theresa Hawro Endowed Scholarship.

Alumna **Barbara Campagna '63** established the Vincent J. and Philomena Pepe Campagna Endowed Scholarship in memory of her parents. The three Campagna sisters followed one right after the other beginning with Ann '55, Elizabeth '56 and Barbara '63.

Barbara says, "The scholarship is a way that I could give back. I hope those who benefit will 'pay it forward.""




CAROL SHEPARDSON COLVIN '82

Carol's most profound impact was her work with the first facility to function as a drug and alcohol halfway house and supportive living program for women and children in Cayuga County.






