



A Letter from the College President



It is exciting news that I have to share with you! D'Youville is engaged in a brand new venture—one that will extend the college campus southward and enhance the Westside of Buffalo. Last year, D'Youville purchased the large building at 605 Niagara Street. This building was formerly the home of Gateway-Longview Services for Children and Haven House, the refuge for battered women and children. The building originally housed the Buffalo Deaconess Home of the Methodist Episcopal Church and later became the Protestant Home for Unprotected Children.

Built in phases beginning in 1890, it is a major structure that will be completely renovated by D'Youville College this year and will serve as the new academic hub for liberal arts, science, education and business. It will boast of state-of-the-art classrooms and science laboratories needed by undergraduates in nearly every major offered at D'Youville. There will be study places, faculty offices and small seminar rooms to serve additional needs of contemporary students. Because the science labs in the Alt Building (formerly the Health Science Building) date back to the 1960s and because so many undergraduate students take a number of science courses, it became clear that we either need to overhaul the Alt laboratories or to create new ones. When the recently purchased Gateway-Longview building became available, it seemed most prudent that we expand the campus on Niagara Street and provide for the students the space and accommodations that they require for their undergraduate programs.

Farther north on Niagara Street at the corner of Vermont, there lies the former site of St. Mary's Church and parsonage. Because of the condition of those buildings, the city determined that it would be prudent to tear them down and to put the vacant property on the auction block. D'Youville had the successful bid

and was able to acquire this space for much needed campus parking. However, during subsequent meetings with the neighborhood it was determined that, as homage to the good work that was done by St. Mary's parish while the church was operational, the bell that had been preserved might be displayed on the new parking site. D'Youville gladly agreed and now the college will be one of very few places in the city where a parking lot boasts of a beautiful large church bell that has been restored and encased within a new custom-built arch.

Along with these building projects on Niagara Street, D'Youville was able to conclude its negotiations with the city of Buffalo and to purchase the land on Fourth Street and Porter Avenue, across from the entrance to the thruway and to the Peace Bridge. This site encompasses approximately 3.4 acres that will be used for outdoor athletic fields that will feature artificial turf and new lighting, a field house and visitor parking. The athletic fields are slated to be completed by July 2014 and will be used for men's and women's soccer, men's and women's lacrosse and women's softball. This additional property will afford outdoor athletic fields for D'Youville for the first time in the college's 105-year history. This addition is most important for the physical well-being of the students and for the success of the NCAA Division III teams at D'Youville.

You are God's building. [1 Cor. 3:9c]

All of us, however, know that education is not simply about buildings but, more importantly, about the pursuit of ideas, the exchange between teachers and students and students and teachers and the generation of new and exciting knowledge. In other words, it is not so much the building but the *people* that make the building come alive with energy and purpose. Believing that, I would like to share with you some of the ways that D'Youville, springing from its mission, takes seriously its commitment to educate for life and provides the students not only with knowledge but with the *desire* to continue to learn and to share what they learn with all those around them.

As in the past two years, D'Youville College has once again taken on the hunger initiative. Currently, the effort has expanded to include safe clean water, as well as food. The focus is not only on our own community but on remote locations throughout the world where there is famine and thirst. It amazes me how creative the members of the D'Youville community are in their ability to evaluate and respond to the needs of the poor, the hungry, and those who suffer from the deprivation of clean water.

We have learned that in 2012 the United Nations Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) estimated that over 865 million people in the world are undernourished. That figure represents about 12 percent of the world's population. In addition, they recognize that malnutrition is the cause of death for more than 2.5 million children each year. Although D'Youville students are not able to reach all those who suffer

from hunger and the lack of clean water, nevertheless, they are able to make a difference in the lives of many through their efforts and, more importantly, to instill in each other the desire to use their resources, including their education, to provide for those who suffer from these serious consequences.

Accordingly, this year, 2013-14, D'Youville is expanding this initiative and is collecting food for the poor, preparing students to take mission trips to distant lands, working in local soup kitchens, researching and caring for those who suffer from diabetes and other food-related ailments and responding in creative ways to the malnutrition suffered not only here, but also in other countries. All members of the college community—faculty, staff, students and alumni—are encouraged to engage actively in responding to this human need that is so prevalent in our time.

We all know what it is like to crave for knowledge and humankind seems to share a voracious desire for a deeper understanding of the human heart. We thirst for wisdom. As we learn to peel away each mystery through the journey of education, we uncover yet another—each one leading to the great mystery of life itself, our compassionate God. How privileged we are to be a part of D'Youville and to have as our purpose the desire for this journey and the opportunity to join with others and share our discoveries and new questions with them! Isn't this the heart of the teaching and learning process and the idea of D'Youville's motto, "Educating for Life?"

To continue to attract students and to prepare them for emerging professional opportunities, D'Youville has developed an innovative academic program, the bachelor of science in health analytics. Recently the New York State Education Department (NYSED) approved this new program. The curriculum should be a most attractive one for D'Youville because it is based on the college's strengths and will educate students for an emerging professional field. Health analytics comprises an understanding of health care, an ability to work with computers and statistics and an interest in mathematics. All of these individual academic subsets have strong underpinnings at D'Youville and the program itself is composed of many courses that the college offers currently, along with new courses pertinent to the field of analytics. The college will begin the program in September 2014. Health analytics has generated much enthusiasm among potential students, employers and guidance counselors.

D'Youville has seen, as well, an expansion of research that will have an impact on a range of society's needs. Many faculty who are engaging in research, particularly in the fields of health care and science, are encouraging students to work with them. This opportunity for the students builds a great foundation in learning the connection of research to intellectual life and the desire to find new ways to assist

humankind. Pharmacy faculty are engaged in cutting-edge cancer research to discover how the spread of disease can be stopped.


- Dr. Shoshanna Zucker, a member of the pharmacy faculty, has been involved for a number of years in this type of cancer research and has encouraged students to work with her.
- Dietetics and science faculty have worked on food concerns among the elderly and have presented a paper on the measurement of the “impact of home-delivered meals on food insecurity in the elderly population.”
- A doctoral faculty member, Dr. Margaret Mblizi, has presented research on the challenges of building the capacity of women parliamentarians in Malawi, Africa.
- An education faculty member, Dr. David Gorlewski, has presented his research on using case story methodology for social justice.
- A member of the sociology faculty, Dr. Julia Hall, has signed contracts to write three books in her specialty area of human rights research.

As you can see, the longing for knowledge and the hunger and thirst for justice remain important motivations for scholarly research and publication at D’Youville. Constantly, faculty try to engage their students in understanding ideas, while simultaneously instilling in them the desire to address issues of social justice.

Clearly, the model for a D’Youville education is still the combination of the intellectual preparation of students in conjunction with a deep desire to combine that knowledge with a compassionate heart so that the graduate recognizes the responsibility to care for others and has the knowledge and resourcefulness to do so.

I am continuously reminded that all of our efforts must simply be focused on the purpose of educating our students in the best possible manner, not only in a way that feeds their intellectual capacity, but also in a way that assists their psychological, physical and spiritual development.
What we have learned we share joyously with others on their journey—that is the fearsome and awesome responsibility of all those who educate. The lives we encounter are changed forever, as we, in turn, are changed by theirs.

D’Youville is able to educate in an exceptional way because of the quality of its faculty, the example of its alumni and friends and the mission that inspires us. As I think of the many generations of people who have been touched by the spirit of D’Youville, through the college itself or through its graduates, I am reminded of an experience I had this summer that symbolizes D’Youville’s mission to learn, to teach, and to do so always with a spirit of love. A member of the D’Youville alumni died and I attended the memorial service for her. Although I knew some things about the woman’s life and interests, I learned at the service what an incredibly strong impact she had had as a science teacher on the lives of




others. When speaking of her years in teaching, one after the other of her colleagues and former students attested to her great ability to teach science to women and to excite them in a way that overcame their fear of science and engendered in them the desire to learn more.

As I listened to the testimonials, I realized that not only did this teacher inspire young women to learn about science, but more importantly, she lit a fire in them that grew and flared to the point where they loved science and found in themselves an unquenchable desire to continue to learn. She was able to ignite in them the same fire that lived so brilliantly within herself. Through her, the worlds of those young women were transformed and learning science became a joy. As a teacher, she was able to see the hunger, the fear and the yearning of her students and to create in them the confidence to overcome that fear and to foster in them a lifelong eagerness to explore.



NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Health ANALYTICS



D'Youville's application for a new undergraduate program in health analytics has been approved by the New York State Education Department and will begin to enroll students in fall 2014.

Analytics is defined as the method of logical analysis and is explained as the discovery and communication of meaningful patterns in data. The term is one that is used ever more frequently in business, media and technology circles. Even the Buffalo Bills have just created a position and a director of analytics has been hired to analyze every aspect of their football operation. The term "Big Data" is also thrown about in relation to analytics, indicating that there sits "out there" a treasure trove of data that can be utilized in the decision-making process of any business or even any football team, ultimately to describe, predict and improve performance.

The problem that the college uncovered in its research on analytics is that there are not enough people trained in this area to fill the need. Conversations held with local healthcare leaders indicated that there is a robust job market for such individuals and that starting salaries are very attractive as well. With the growth in electronic healthcare records, spurred on by the Affordable Care Act and the call

for increased efficiency in healthcare and healthcare costs it is predicted that this field of employment has a bright future. To meet this growing need in the health care industry the college designed this new program and received quick approval from the state education department.

The four-year program will focus on areas relevant to analytics including mathematics and statistical analysis. Additional aspects of the program will include courses in medical terminology, healthcare and wellness, and information technology. Students with a strong aptitude for math and statistical analysis would be ideal candidates for this program.

D'Youville is known for its strong programs in healthcare that have centered on patient care. This program builds on another strength of the college that focuses on the business side of the health industry. The college already has an undergraduate program in health services, a master's degree program in health services administration and a doctoral program in health administration. It is conceivable that the graduates of the new health analytics program will eventually be of service to the graduates of these existing programs as well as to those involved in the area of healthcare research.

The challenge for the college and our admissions area is to get the word out on this relatively new field and to let the general public know of its vast potential. A recent meeting with area high school counselors showed great enthusiasm for the program and the counselors were especially happy to have another very viable field of study available for their math students.

Dr. Anthony Billittier IV, dean of the School of Health Professions at D'Youville, indicates that "with the creation of electronic health records providing all the data on patient's care replacing paper records that were difficult to analyze, the data will allow decisions to be evidence based rather than just what someone thinks. We need to improve healthcare and our new program will go a long way to accomplish the goal of quality healthcare."

Sister Mary Ann held that position until 1981 when she assumed the position of administrator. She became a revered figure in that role and served in that position until 1999.

Sister Mary Ann did not limit her service to the hospital but, also, provided service to the larger community. In 1999, she was appointed vice president of long-term care for the Catholic Health System. In 2000, she assumed a leadership role as vice president for her religious congregation, the Sisters of Mercy. During her service on the Mercy leadership team, her religious congregation merged with other Mercy groups in the Northeast United States.

In all of her responsibilities in health care and congregational leadership, Sister Mary Ann became known for her compassion, concern, presence and support. She possesses the rare combination of creative leadership and compassionate kindness and uses these qualities generously whenever she is called to serve. Currently, Sister Mary Ann is a member of the board of trustees at Trocaire College and Mercyhurst University. Sister Mary Ann volunteers at Gerard Place, Harvest House Education and Health Center and at Transitional Housing for Homeless Families, an organization that was formed by the religious women's congregations in the Diocese of Buffalo. Previously, Sister Mary Ann served as a member of the D'Youville College Board of Trustees and in several advisory capacities for the International Rotary, the Masons, the state of New York and Canisius College.

In the example of St. Marguerite d'Youville, Sister Mary Ann Schimscheiner has devoted her life and her talents to recognizing and responding to the needs of the sick and of the poor. Her intrepid faith has led her to find in all humankind the face of God.

The Anne Lum Award was initiated in 1971 and is named for one of the college's early alumni secretaries, the late Anne Ryan Lum '24 who established the Alumni Loyalty Fund. Its intent is to honor a graduate of D'Youville College who is distinguished through professional achievement, involvement in community affairs, service to D'Youville College or any combination of these factors. This award is the most coveted honor given by the D'Youville College Alumni Association.
