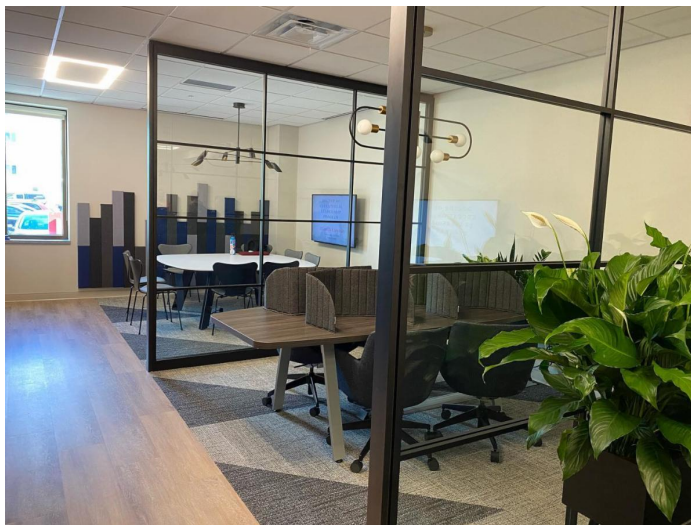

- [VPAA Initiatives](#) to support faculty and student scholarly engagements. Funding opportunities for the following three programs, apply by April 11, 2023: A-Faculty Research Release Time Grants (3 credits/semester), B- Faculty Led Student Research program grants (up to \$4,500 for students, \$3,000 for faculty), C- Student Apprentice Grants (up to \$1,980 a semester)
- **Research Committee** has still large amount of funds to distribute for this year. Please [apply for their funding](#) for summer research or buying small equipment, etc.
- **CSTEP** invites faculty to work with summer research students funded by the CSTEP program. The Summer Enrichment Research Program is an 8.5-week program that plans to offer intensive research experience and the skills needed to pursue scientific professions or graduate school. Students in this program are fully funded for summer. All faculty participants receive a \$3,000 stipend from the VPAA office; additionally, CSTEP will provide a bonus stipend to participating faculty. Lucia Rossi

Lucia Rossi, a current Health Administration Doctoral Program student at D'youville University, is the Vice President of Ambulatory Services and Population Health at Erie County Medical Center (ECMC).



She oversees 28 outpatient ambulatory care centers, including those offering specialty services and primary care. Her leadership role also includes Employee Health for ECMC team members and organizations in the community.

Lucia works to combat health disparities and break down barriers to care for patients as the head of the Population Health Team. During the pandemic, she increased telehealth, added an outdoor testing facility, and led over 25 vaccination clinics throughout the city providing over 55,000 Covid-19 vaccinations.

Aligned with this work, she enjoys mentoring other students in their healthcare career and education goals.
