

October 26 (4pm, Thursday): Thursday Thirst for Knowledge Series: "Fuzzy-set Qualitative Comparative Analysis" Henry Boateng, PhD: Fuzzy-set Qualitative comparative analysis (fsQCA) is an asymmetric data analysis method that integrates fundamental concepts from qualitative and quantitative analysis techniques. It combines fuzzy logic and set theory elements to identify patterns and configurations that lead to specific outcomes. fsQCA helps researchers to study cases with limited variation and accounts for the presence of multiple causal pathways. FsQCA is an emerging method primarily employed in the social sciences, including sociology, political science, management, organizational studies, public/ health administration, monitoring and evaluation, and recently in nursing and education research. It is beneficial when studying complex social phenomena where linear cause-and-effect models do not easily explain causal relationships.
