- Any individuals from the general public aged 18 years or older willing to participate via internet and social media

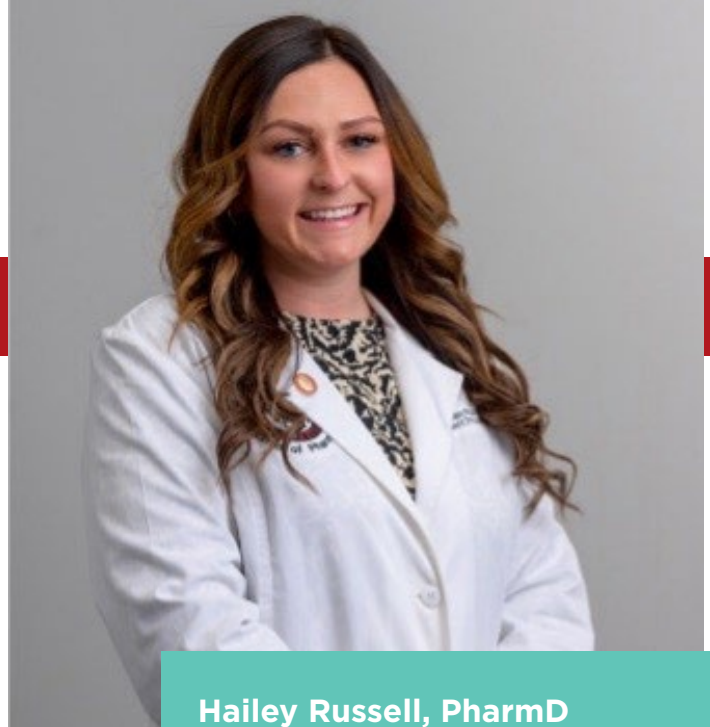
**Exclusion Criteria:**

- Individuals without a current or historical diagnosis of a mental health condition involving pharmacotherapy

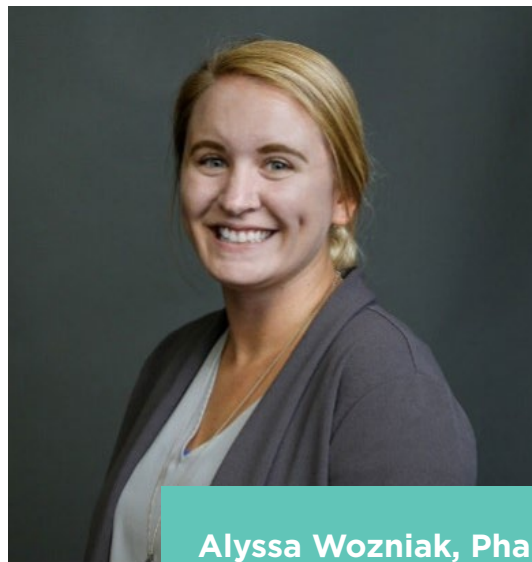
**Survey Details:**
